Booking Process

- 1) Review the Facility Rental Guide to determine the venue most suitable for your event
- 2) Check the online Facility Schedule (if available) at fernie.ca/recreation
- 3) Submit a **Booking Request Form** and **Signed Rental Agreement** to recreation@fernie.ca
- 4) Once you receive a rental permit, use the online portal to purchase insurance for your booking.

Insurance:

The City of Fernie requires users to have insurance, and a copy of your insurance certificate must be provided. The certificate must indicate a minimum of \$5 Million in general liability. The following option is available through Municipal Insurance Association of BC:

Option 1: Standard/No Changes

Ice pad, removal of selected boards, sills and glass for exits. Installation of accessible ramps.

Option 3: Large conversion

Installation of ice covering, removal of boards, sills and glass for exits. Installation of accessible ramps.





Gym Floor Rental Requirements:

Please be aware of the following gym use requirements when doing a gym floor rental only (Community Centre and Max Turyk Community Centre Gym):

- Food and beverage is not permitted in the gym
- Clean, dry indoor shoes must be worn in the gym – be sure to advise your guests to bring a change of footwear
- Bikes are not permitted in the gym
- Renters must bring their own sport equipment for personal use
- Gym floor must be left clean and dry for the group arriving next

Bouncy Castles:

Operation of bouncy castles is not permitted unless operated by a licensed contractor with the required permits from Technical Safety BC at any venue where the public has access. www.technicalsafetybc.ca/amusement-devices

Special Events:
